<i>UN_vote_PctAgreeUS</i>	This is Lijphart's index of agreement between the state and the U.S. This equals 1 if a state always agrees with the U.S. 0 if it always votes the other way. If one state votes yes and the other abstains, the vote is coded as .5.
<i>UN_vote_PctAgreeRUSSIA</i>	Index of agreement between the state and Russia
<i>UN_vote_PctAgreeBrazil</i>	Index of agreement between the state and Brazil
<i>UN_vote_PctAgreeChina</i>	Index of agreement between the state and China
<i>UN_vote_PctAgreeIndia</i>	Index of agreement between the state and India
<i>UN_vote_PctAgreeIsrael</i>	Index of agreement between the state and Israel

Explanation for minor conflict and civil war:

Minor conflict: deaths < 1000 in a year

Civil war: deaths \geq 1000 in a year
